The ILCB is located in Aix-en-Provence, Avignon and Marseille and includes several top research laboratories in linguistics, psychology, cognitive neuroscience, medicine, computer science, and mathematics.

Interested candidates must contact one or two PhD supervisors amongst the members of the ILCB (<https://www.ilcb.fr/members/ilcb-fellows/>). All projects must be supervised by at least one member of the ILCB.

Together with the supervisor(s), the candidates must write a 3-year PhD project. Priority is given to interdisciplinary projects that involve two different laboratories of the institute and to co-directed projects.

The application should contain:

1. A full description of the PhD project (~ 5 pages):
 1. Title
 2. Name of the PhD supervisor(s)
 3. Short Summary
 4. Scientific context/state of the art/
 5. Objectives and hypotheses
 6. Methodology
 7. Expected results
 8. Brief statement about the relevance of the project for the ILCB
 9. Proposed Timeline
2. CV and master degree grades (if available)
3. Letter of motivation
4. One letter of recommendation or contact information of a potential referee

Deadline for submission: Avril 30, 2021

Auditions: May 15, 2021 (international candidates might be interviewed via zoom)

Start: October 1, 2021

Monthly salary: 1 685€ (1 368€ net) for a period of 3 years
